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DR. OLAJIDE PHILIP SOBUKOLA has been very active in training and capacity building in the field of Food Science and Technology at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels for about fifteen years in Nigeria. His research focus is Food Processing and Preservation with emphasis on application of engineering principles to design Food processes and optimizing quality of Food products. He currently serves as the Deputy Programme Leader (Food Processing and Value Addition) at the World Bank Centre of Excellence in Agricultural Development and Sustainable Environment (CEADESE) anchored FUNAAB. He was the former head of Department, Food Science and Technology, Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta, Nigeria. He graduated from the University of Agriculture, (now Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta, FUNAAB), Nigeria as the overall best graduating student with four distinct academic awards (1998/1999 session). He completed his Master of Science (2003) and PhD (2007) degrees in Food Processing and Storage Technology from the same University. He had his postdoctoral training at the Department of Chemical and Bioprocess Engineering, Pontificia Universidad Catolica de Chile, Santiago, Chile, where he worked in the area of Food Process design in relation to development and microstructural analysis of vacuum and atmospherically fried fabricated matrices. Dr. Sobukola is also an IFS grantee on vacuum frying of sweet potato slices from different varieties. He has supervised over seven PhD theses, more than sixty Master of Science (MSc) dissertations and is author of scores of articles in international and national peer reviewed journals. Dr. Sobukola also serves as a reviewer to many journals in his field and other allied fields. His current research interests include using novel Food production technology such as vacuum and air frying in the development of nutritious and safe snacks among others. These efforts had generated interest in and outside Nigeria especially with the vast majority of fast food operators. Presently, his latest research findings involve development of fried chicken nuggets using local chicken and novel technology. Dr. Sobukola is widely travelled and is an ordained Pastor with Living Faith Church, World-wide (Winners' Chapel).
